## Area - Tunnels

Hazard	Risk	People at risk	Risk Control
Slips, trips and falls	Cuts, grazes, sprains and breaks	Tunnel Users	Leaders shall be conversant with the equipment and supervise the activity at all times. This cannot be used without booking via Ruth. Safety briefing including correct use of equipment and safety helmets to be worn at all times and arms/legs to be covered (gloves optional). First Aider on site.
Confined Spaces	Physical injury,	Tunnel Users	Supervision at all times. Emergency exits to be unlocked and tunnel system to be "Aired" for a minimum of 10 minutes inspected and checked by leader. Maximum of 12 participants in the tunnels system at anyone time, although you may wish to reduce for the older users.... Scouts / Explorers. Helmets to be worn at all times. Participants asked to remove loose items from their pockets.
Confined Spaces	Claustrophobia or panic attacks	Tunnel Users	Participants to be asked before entering if they have a fear of enclosed spaces, if so the emergency doors can be left open and the user should be buddied up and issued with a torch. But under no circumstances should a user have undue pressure put upon them to take part.
Tunnels System	Physical injury	Tunnel Users	Tunnels System to be inspected thoroughly before use and any defects to be reported and equipment not to be used.
Adverse Weather	Physical injury	Tunnel Users	Brief on dangers of slippery conditions and trapped water.
