Site users please read....

Discovery of a fire

Raise the alarm by shouting 'FIRE!', 'FIRE!' and warn people in the vicinity of the fire. Do not put yourself at risk. Leave the building straight away.

Alarms

If you hear the smoke alarm, follow the evacuation procedures without delay.

Alerting the emergency services

This should be done by anyone finding a fire at the soonest opportunity. They need to dial 999 and ask for the fire service – use your mobile phone

People with you

Please take responsibility for any young people and visitors that may be with you and ensure they know how to follow the evacuation procedure.

Assembly point – x 2

Upon evacuating the building / camping areas, proceed to the nearest assembly point

- open area just past the toilet block towards the plateau area.
- Car park
